

The 5 Commitments of C3 Music Teams

1. Worship God w/ my entire life

Worship is:

- Bringing **Pleasure** to God
"You are worthy, O Lord our God, to receive glory and honor and power. For you created everything, and it is for your pleasure that they exist and were created." - Revelations 4:11
- Areas **I can** bring pleasure to God
 - My attitude:
 - Worshipful
 - Flexible
 - Teachable
 - The way I show care for my teammates
 - Refusing to gossip
 - Praying for them
 - Encouraging, supporting... when they are chosen to take the lead over me
 - The way I speak about my church
 - Praying for my church / leaders
 - Following the leaders
"So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life – your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life and place it before God as an offering." - Romans 12:1
- 3 Areas of **Commitment**:
 - **Personal** – I will spend time w/ God daily
 - **Team Growth** – I will attend and grow with my team both musically / technically and relationally
 - **Sunday Attendance** – I will celebrate with my church regularly

2. Live with Excellence

Excellence is:

- **Doing the best I can** with what God has given me

Living with Excellence means:

- Lead a **God-honoring life**
"God wants us to grow up... like Christ in everything." - Ephesians 4:15
- Continue to **grow** as an artist / technician
"Sing to Him a new song: play skillfully with a shout of joy". – Psalms 33:3
- Always being **prepared**
"Work hard and cheerfully at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people". – Colossians 3:23

3. Become a **Servant-Leader**

Jesus: *"Your attitude must be like My Own, for I did not come to be served, but to serve..."* - Matthew 20:28

Servant Leader process:

- C3 Attender
- Creative Team Member
- Serve Regularly
- Assisting Leader
- Team Leader

4. Share **my life with others**

- Encourage my **teammates** to grow
"... Let everything you say be good and helpful, so that your words will be an encouragement to those who hear them." - Ephesians 4:29
- Inviting those who are not yet Christians **towards Christ**
"For anyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them?" - Romans 10:13-15
- Inviting people to **join me** on the team

5. Giving of my **time, treasure, and talent**

- Honor God with my **Time**

- Honor God with my **Treasure**
