“The Lord God said, ‘It is **not good** for the man to be alone.’” Genesis 2:18

“For Adam no suitable helper was found. So the Lord God caused the man to fall into a deep sleep, and while he was sleeping, He took one of the man’s ribs and then closed up the place with flesh. Then the Lord God made a woman from the rib he had taken out of the man, and he brought her to the man.” Genesis 2:20-22

- “The man said, ‘This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called ‘woman,’ for she was taken out of man. That is why a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they become one flesh. Adam and his wife were both naked, and they felt no shame.’” Genesis 2:23-25

GOD created marriage!

“Those who marry **will** face many troubles in this life.” 1 Corinthians 7:28

What are the purposes of marriage?

1) **PROCREATION**

· “So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God He created them; male and female He created them. God blessed them and said to them, ‘Be fruitful and increase in number....’” Genesis 1:27-28

2) **ILLUSTRATION**

· “Wives, submit to your husbands **as you do to the Lord**. For the husband is the head of the wife as **Christ is the head of the church**, his body, of which he is the Savior. Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives, **just as Christ loved the church** and gave himself up for her.” Ephesians 5:22-25

“‘This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called ‘woman’, for she was taken out of man.’ That is why a man leaves his father and mother and is united to his wife, and they become **one** flesh.” Genesis 2:23-24

- You can’t **UN-ONE** what God has made **ONE** !
