What does the Bible say about marriage:

- 1) God created marriage to be between 1 MAN & 1 WOMAN
 - Genesis 2:22-25
- 2) God designed marriage to be a permanent **ONE-NESS**
 - Matthew 19:4-6
- 3) God says marriage is a **COVENANT**
 - Malachi 2:14, Proverbs 2:17
- 4) God charges the **HUSBAND** to take responsibility for the family
 - Ephesians 5:22-31, 1 Timothy 5:8, Colossians 3:18-21, 1 Peter 3:1-7
- 5) God hates **DIVORCE**
 - Malachi 2:14-16

What is an allowable end of marriage in Scripture?

- 1) **DEATH** of a spouse
 - 1 Corinthians 7:39
- 2) ADULTERY
 - Matthew 5:32
- 3) **ABANDONMENT**
 - 1 Corinthians 7:15
- 4) Hardness of **HEART**
 - Matthew 19:8

Common questions about divorce & remarriage:

- 1) What about abusive relationships, should I stay?
 - <u>NO</u>
- 2) Do I have to take them back if they commit adultery?
 - IF POSSIBLE
 - 1 Corinthians 7:10-11
- 3) Am I allowed to remarry after a divorce? After all efforts of
 - RECONCILIATION
 - 1 Corinthians 7, Matthew 5, & Matthew 19

C3 Group Questions

What implication does "Husbands love your wife just as Christ loved the church" have?

How does the modern day view of marriage compare to this passage?

In your own words, how would you explain the main goal of a Christian marriage?

Read 1 Corinthians 7:10-16. In a nutshell, what does Paul teach in this passage about marriage, divorce, & remarriage? How does this compare to the views of our society at large?

How can this group pray for you this week? Who in this group can you pray for this week?
