"The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous run to Him and are safe." Proverbs 18:10

2 of the most personal & important questions you'll ever answer:

1) "What am I going to do with **MY LIFE?**"

- Genesis 12:2-4
- "The Lord had said to Abram, 'Leave your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you.'" Verse 1
- "He took his wife Sarai, his nephew Lot, all the possessions they had accumulated and the people they had acquired in Harran, and they set out for the land of Canaan, and they arrived there." verse 5

Questions to ask yourself about your job:

- 1) Am I using the **ABILITIES & TALENTS** God has given me?
- 2) Am I doing the **JOB** for more than just money?
- 3) Have I found ways to love God & **LOVE PEOPLE** when I'm at work?
- 4) How does this job affect my **SPIRITUAL LIFE** & my **FAMILY LIFE**?
- 5) Am I glorifying God with **WHAT I DO?**

*"Whatever you do, **do it all for the glory of God.**" 1 Corinthians 10:31*

2) Who am I going to **MARRY?**

- 1 Peter 3:4-6
- "Do not be yoked together with unbelievers." 2 Corinthians 6:14
- "Whoever trusts in the Lord is kept safe." Proverbs 29:25
- This is your one & only life. **ENJOY IT.**
- Life is short. Give it **YOUR ALL**
- The race is long. **STAY WITH IT**
- Go to heaven & take as **MANY PEOPLE** with you as possible.
- Make your life **COUNT FOR THE LORD**

C3 Group Questions

Accountability: Were you at church on Sunday to grow & learn? Did you read/listen to the Bible & pray this week on a regular basis? If so, share what stood out to you in your time with God?

Ice Breaker: Where is “home” for you? When did you leave there? What for?

Review: What one thing stood out to you (either helpful, insightful or troubling) from the weekend’s message?

Group Discussion:

Read Genesis 12:1-4. What command does God give Abram? What promise does God give Abram if Abram does God’s command? Did Abram obey God’s command & receive God’s promise?

During the weekend message, Mark mentioned one of the questions in life we all ask ourselves is, “What will I do with my life?”

Share as a group your answers to these 5 questions that were given in the weekend message:

- 1) Am I using the abilities & talents God has given me? If not, why? If so, how?
- 2) Am I doing my job for more than just money?
- 3) Have I found ways to love God & love people when I’m at work, or school, or wherever I spend my time?
- 4) How does this job affect my spiritual life & my family life?
- 5) Am I glorifying God with what I do?

1 Corinthians 10:31 says, *“Whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.”*

What does that verse mean to you? What does that look like when you are at home, at work, at school, with your friends, when you’re doing menial tasks?

“A career is what you’re paid for, but a calling is what you’re made for.”

What does this statement mean to you? Do you believe that statement? Why or why not?

Another question posed in the weekend message was, “Who will I marry?”

- If married, how did you decide who you would marry?
- If single, how should you decide who you should marry?
- What are some things the Bible tells us to look for when we are looking to get married?

How can this group pray for you this week? Who in this group can you pray for this week?

Next Steps: (*“Do not merely listen to the word.....Do what it says.” James 1:22*)

- Continue to ask yourself the 5 questions that were given in the weekend message. Be honest with yourself on each question. In areas that you know you are not doing well in, invite God to come into those areas & allow Him to help you!
