

"Blind Bartimaeus" Underdog Series Pastor Mark 5.17.20

"Then they came to Jericho. As Jesus and his disciples, together with a large crowd, were leaving the city, a blind man, Bartimaeus (the son of Timaeus), was sitting by the roadside begging." Mark 10:46

"When Bartimaeus <u>heard</u> that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout, 'Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!'" Mark 10:47

Don't focus so much on what you **DON'T** have, that you forget what you **DO** have!

- Romans 12:6-9

*"Many people rebuked him and told Bartimaeus to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" Mark 10:48* 

If you always do what you've always done, you're only going to have what you always <u>HAD</u>!

"Jesus stopped and said, 'Call him.' So they called to the blind man. 'Cheer up! On your feet! He's calling you!' Throwing his cloak aside, he jumped to his feet and came to Jesus." Mark 10:49-50

- "What do you want me to do for you?" Jesus asked him. The blind man said, "Rabbi, I want to see." Verse 51
- "Jesus said, 'Go, your faith has healed you.' Immediately he receives his sight and he followed Jesus along the road." Verse 52

Our value is in who **<u>GOD</u>** says we are, not in what **<u>OTHERS</u>** say.
