"Make every effort to live in <u>peace with everyone</u> and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord. See to it that no one falls short of the grace of God and that <u>no bitter root grows up</u> to cause trouble and defile many." Hebrews 12:14-15

## 2 Biblical thoughts about bitterness:

- 1) Bitterness has a **DANGEROUS ROOT**.
  - "See to it that.....no bitter root grows...." Hebrews 12:15
  - Roots <u>ABORG.....GROW.....& STORE</u>.
- 2) Bitterness produces a **POISONOUS ROOT**.
  - "Watch out that <u>no poisonous root of bitterness</u> grows up to trouble you, <u>corrupting many</u>." Hebrews 12:15 (New Living Translation)

## 5 Qualities of Bitter people:

- 1) Bitter people **JUSTIFY** their bitterness.
- 2) Bitter people become CRITICAL.
- 3) Bitter people celebrate the **MISFORTUNES OF OTHERS**.
- 4) Bitter people tend to **WRITE OFF** entire groups of people.
- 5) Bitter people often don't see bitterness **IN THEIR OWN LIFE**.

## How do we kill the root of bitterness?

- We kill the root of bitterness with **FORGIVENESS**.
  - "Get rid of all <u>bitterness</u>, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another <u>forgiving each other</u>, just as in Christ God forgave you." Ephesians 4:31-32
  - You must **CHOOSE** to forgive!
  - ".....forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." Ephesians 4:32

## Why is forgiveness so important?

- "For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, <u>your heavenly Father will also forgive</u> you. But if you do <u>not forgive</u> others their sins, <u>your Father will not forgive your sins</u>."

Matthew 6:14-15
