

"How to Forgive Others" How to Forgive.... Series Pastor Mark 4.25.21

## Steps to forgiving others:

- 1) **<u>REMEMBER</u>** how much <u>YOU</u> have been forgiven.
- "Come, let us talk this over" says the Lord. "No matter how deep the stain of your sin, I can talk it out and make you as clean as freshly fallen snow. Even if you are stained as red as crimson, I can make you <u>white as wool</u>." Isaiah 1:18
- "Parable of the Unforgiving Servant" Matthew 18:23-35
- 2) **<u>RELASE</u>** the person entirely.
- What does "release" mean?
  - It means to **SET THEM FREE** & no longer hold onto **BITTERNESS** or **RESENTMENT**.
  - Forgiveness is always a **<u>CHOICE</u>**.
  - Practical ways we can release a person entirely:
    - a) **WRITE A LETTER** to the person that hurt you.
    - b) Have an **IMAGINARY CONVERSATION** with the person.
  - "Never pay back evil for evil to anyone. Do things in such a way that everyone can see you are honorable. Dear friends, never avenge yourselves. <u>Leave that to God.</u> For it is written, I will take vengeance. I will repay those who deserve it says the Lord." Romans 12:17-19
- 3) **<u>RECOGNIZE</u>** God's purpose in the process.
- "God works all things together for good to those who love the Lord and are called according to His purpose." Romans 8:28
- "Don't be afraid of me. Am I God, that I can punish you? You intended to harm me, but God intended it <u>all for good</u>. He brought me to this position so I could save the lives of many people." Genesis 50:19-20

## 4) **REESTABLISH?**

- This step is <u>CONDITIONAL</u>
  - Forgiveness & reconciliation are **<u>NOT</u>** the same.
- "Do your part to live in peace with everyone, as much as possible." Romans 12:18
- 5) **<u>REPEAT</u>** the process.
- We are to forgive "seventy times seven" Matthew 18:22
- "If you forgive those who sin against you, your Heavenly Father will forgive you. But if <u>you refuse to</u> <u>forgive</u> others, your Father will <u>not forgive your sins</u>." Matthew 6:14-15
