3 types of Together-Time we all need:

Together-Time with **GOD**

- "And the Scripture was fulfilled that says, 'Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness'—and he was called <u>a friend of God</u>." James 2:23
- ".....do not live the rest of your earthly lives for evil human desires, but rather for the <u>will of God</u>."

- "Let the message of Christ dwell among you <u>richly</u> as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom." Colossians 3:16
- "Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful." Colossians 4:2

Together-Time with **SPOUSE**
