C3's Mission statement is: “Leading people into NEW & GROWING relationships with Jesus.”

Matthew 23:37 - 24:1

*Jesus left the temple and was walking away when his disciples came to him to call his attention to its **buildings**. - Matthew 24:1*

*Jesus said, “Do you see all these **things**?” - Matthew 24:2*

*I tell you the truth, not one **stone** here will be on another, every one will be thrown down. - Matthew 24:2*

Watch how the importance of the temple has diminished in just a few lines:

- From **HOUSE**...to **BUILDINGS**....to **THINGS**....to **STONES**.
- As far as Jesus is concerned, a church is not a building or an organization.
- A church is **PEOPLE**, & nothing else!

When a church gets off it's Mission & forgets what it's about, or WHO it's about, Jesus is out of here!

“GROWING” means becoming more like JESUS!

Knowledge alone makes Christians **ARROGANT**.

Applying it makes us **HOLY**!
